



**Cash and security products available
for village halls, community centres, local monuments and landmarks**
Through the Burg-Wächter Secure Communities Scheme



*Supporting the use and maintenance of
village halls and community spaces*

Projects supporting or using communal spaces ranging from village halls to community centres, or activities in aid of anything from monuments to local landmarks are all eligible to apply for a **Secure Communities Scheme** award. This scheme offers up to £1,000 cash plus security products to grass roots community projects. The cash can be spent on fund raising activities for new build, refurbishment or improvement projects or used to support activities that use community owned or run spaces. In particular the scheme is targeting grass roots projects that would not normally attract funding, where a relatively small amount of money can make a big difference.

The **Secure Communities Scheme** is seeking applications for cash and support. A fund of £1,000 a month is available. Awards are made based on the potential for positive local impact especially in regards to increasing local security. Priority is given to applications of under £500 in order to benefit the maximum number of causes. Award winners also benefit from security advice in relation to their applications plus access to free security products. Burg-Wächter, the company behind the scheme provides successful applicants with a tailored security kit, specially designed to meet their needs. This covers locks, security cables and chains, smart security cameras and alarms, door and window security products, post boxes and safes.

Mark Pearson from Burg-Wächter commented: *“We are known for our safes and post boxes alongside our extensive range of locking products. We regularly receive requests for products to support charitable and community causes, anything from digital door locks or combination padlocks to wifi-cameras and alarms.
