PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2019

HIS order is made by Devon County Council ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the County of Devon definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

The owner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

South Hams District Council has been consulted concerning the making of the order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situate at Bigbury in the County of Devon and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order, and thereupon the County of Devon definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way, provided that this paragraph shall not come into force until the authority certifies that work required to bring the footpath described in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out.
- 2. Notwithstanding this order, where immediately before the date on which the path is diverted in pursuance of this order there is apparatus on under or over the path belonging to the statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking then such undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they would have had if this order had never been made.

- 3. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situate at Bigbury in the County of Devon described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this order, and thereupon the County of Devon definitive map shall be modified by adding that path to it.
- 3A. The County of Devon definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this order.
- 4. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.



PART 4 – MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE STATEMENT VARIATION OF PARTICULARS OF PATH

Footpath No. 4, Bigbury

From: County Road C249 at Bigbury Court

To: County Road B3392 and Footpath 3, Bigbury

The path is a footpath. It starts from the county road C249 at Bigbury Court. It climbs a short flight of steps, then proceeds south-westwards along the field boundary. It continues southwards and then south-eastwards before turning south-westwards again continuing along the field boundary. The path passes a property named Seaview Cottage where it turns south-eastwards remaining along the field boundary to meet footpath 3, Bigbury and the county road, B3392. 40m south-east of Seaview Cottage, an additional short spur of the footpath extends north-westwards, passing through a gate to meet the county road, B3392 opposite Cleave Cottage. The path has a total length of 520 metres.
