# **AVON ESTUARY PATROL**

### **Objectives of the Service**

- To provide a safer and more secure environment for recreational use of the tidal waters by the general public
- To provide a means of recording and reporting back to the Owner, incidents of illegal fishing
- To provide a means of recording and reporting to SHDC and the Owner.
  incidents or risks of potential incidents likely to cause environmental harm
- To provide a suitable patrol boat\* and qualified Warden\* to uphold the byelaws covering the use of watercraft in the tidal area of the Avon Estuary

<sup>\*</sup> SHDC requires all small commercial craft operating within defined limits to obtain a local authority licence for both the vessel and the boatman/operator concerned.

## **AVON ESTUARY PATROL**

#### **Outline of Service Level Agreement**

- Patrol will maintain a daily presence on tidal waters from 1<sup>st</sup> July -30<sup>th</sup> Sept as tides & weather permit
- Operated by Bantham Estate as Agent of SHDC
- Sponsored by ACA, AVSC, BE, DoC (£500 each in cash or kind vs £2500 from SHDC)
- Eventually to be run in conjunction with an improved Bantham to Cockleridge ferry service (part of new England Coast Path)
